THE NORMANDY WORLD PEACE FORUM

As an international event which is open to all, the Normandy World Peace Forum is a hub for reflection and discussion on the themes of peace, freedom and contemporary geopolitics.

Every year, a hundred renowned speakers and several thousand participants, including many secondary school students, meet in the historic grounds of Abbaye-aux-Dames in Caen.

On the agenda: conferences, debates, festive and interactive events, testimonies, a bookshop with author signings, exhibitions, meetings with NGOs and associations....

Objective: to exchange views and to encourage discussions and the search for solutions to help to build lasting peace in the world.

A LOOK BACK AT THE HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2021 FORUM

There were several key events during the 4th edition on the theme of "World peace and global security: how to govern peace?"



The interventions of Fawzia Koofi, Chékéba Hachemi and Ali Maisam Nazary on the situation in Afghanistan following the withdrawal of the American army and the return to power of the Taliban.



The 2021 Freedom Prize awarded to **Sonita Alizada**, an Afghan rapper and activist, for her fight against forced child marriage.



The 6 debates dedicated to young people allowed them to address various issues such as the pressures on freedom of expression, the fight against racism and anti-Semitism, the functioning of the UN, or the role of the European Union in the governance of peace.



The arrival of parliamentarians from all over the world around the Parliamentarians for Peace initiative, led by Open Diplomacy with the support of the Normandy Region. Together, they continued the work of reflection and collaboration on the subjects of peace governance raised during the Forum.



The cultural evening "Peace, on beating drums!" hosted by Michka Assayas of France Inter, in the presence of Véronique Roger-Lacan, French ambassador to UNESCO, cartoonists Zeina Abirached and JUL and artists Elaha Soroor and Piers Faccini.



The focus on regions from the southern Mediterranean to the Middle East, with debates on the situation in Libya, Turkey and Iran.
